ELIGIBILITY

- Applicants must have a cumulative minimum average of 3.0 out of 4.0 to be eligible.
- Applicants must have financial need
- Must be able to provide a presentation to the IBC Board upon return from study abroad
- Funds will be sent directly to the institution to be applied directly to funding of selected student

The College/University winner will be notified by May 1st and will be highlighted at the Upstate New York Trade Conference Banquet on May 13th, 2010 at the Hyatt Regency Hotel in downtown Rochester.
